

## Hanging and Exhibition Fees

*Current members of the SSCA receive a 25% discount on all hanging fees.*

### NONMEMBERS

- The fee for a **FOUR WEEK EXHIBITION** is \$200 divided by the number of artists, or \$25 per person, whichever is higher.
  - IN OTHER WORDS:
    - A solo show costs \$200 for a four week exhibition.
    - A two-person show would cost \$100-per-person ( $2 \times \$100 = \$200$ ), for four weeks.
    - A four-person show is \$50-per-person ( $4 \times \$50 = \$200$ ).
    - An eight-person show would cost \$25 per person ( $8 \times \$25 = \$200$ ).
    - A 10-person show is also \$25-per-person (\$25 is the minimum fee for nonmembers).

The fee for a **TWO-WEEK SOLO EXHIBITION** is \$150

- If several artists wish to share a two-week installation, the cost is \$150, divided by the number of artists, or \$25 per person, whichever is higher (e.g., two artists = \$75 each).
- \$25 is the minimum hanging fee for nonmembers.

- In the case of **ONE-DAY SHOWS** (One Night Only), or **THREE-DAY LIMITED ENGAGEMENTS** (Friday – Sunday), the minimum hanging fee is \$75. (This barely covers the cost of mailing out the postcards to our current mailing list.)

## **MEMBERS**

- Current members of the Stevens Square Center for the Arts (SSCA) receive a 25% discount on all hanging fees.
- To simplify the math, the Members' discount will be rounded-down to the nearest \$5 (e.g., \$15, instead of \$18.75).
- The Members' Fee for a two-week Solo Exhibition is \$110.
- The hanging fee for the annual Members-only Exhibition is \$15

## **EXCEPTIONS**

Under special circumstances, the Board of Directors may elect to waive the hanging fee(s) in exchange for an in-kind donation, or service to the SSCA.

- This should be the exception, rather than the norm.

## **POSTCARDS**

- The SSCA will print 500 postcards for a 4-week exhibition, and 250 postcards for a 2-week show.
- Artists are free to order additional postcards, at their own cost.
- Artists who wish to do single-day events, limited engagements, or weekend shows will have to pay for their own postcards, but the gallery will assume the cost of mailing out up to 250 postcards to our current mailing list.
  - We will continue to send out postcards for annual events such as Zine Fest, and the Opening Night Party for Red Hot Art as if they were regular exhibitions.

## **PROVISIONS REGARDING FOOD AND CATERING AT ART OPENINGS**

- SSCA will provide a cash bar at no extra cost.
- Bar service includes: Beer, Wine, water, and sodas.

- The SSCA will provide up to \$30 worth of food and hors d'oeuvres.
  - The artist(s) are free to provide additional food for the reception, if they so desire.
  - SSCA will staff the set-up, monitoring, and breakdown of the food items & supplies.
  - SSCA will furnish the following items at every opening: plastic cups, plates, utensils, serving trays, and napkins.
